PSA will continue to take a layered approach and monitor their ability to implement *4 key mitigation strategies*:

- Consistent and correct use of masks
- Social distancing
- Hand hygiene
- Cleaning and disinfection

We are seeing more positive cases within the staff and student body. Thank you for taking symptoms seriously and keeping children home when sick.

Remote learning may be considered separately for elementary, middle, and high school. If there are multiple students positive in one grade level, remote learning will be mandatory to mitigate risk of community spread.

Remember:

- Stay home if you feel sick
- Stay home if you are waiting for COVID-19 results
- Report a positive case of COVID-19 to the school within 24 hours
- Masks are required at all times, including recess
- No visitors may enter the building. All communication must be done via phone or door intercom system.

If a student shows signs of COVID-19 during the school day:

- Student (and siblings) will be sent home to monitor symptoms
- Student(s) may return with a negative test or alternative diagnosis

If a student tests positive for COVID-19:

- Stay home regardless of symptoms or vaccination status (Onset of symptoms is Day 0)
- On Day 6, return to school with a mask if a *negative COVID test*, *no fever*, and *other symptoms are improving*.

If a student lives in a home with a COVID-19 positive family member:

- Students must stay home when a member of their home is COVID positive
- Stay home regardless of symptoms or vaccination status (Onset of symptoms is Day 0, student quarantines the same amount of time as positive household member)
- On Day 6, return to school with a mask if a *negative COVID test* and *no fever*. Household members may be required to show proof of negative test results.

For students missing school:

If students are missing school due to COVID/Quarantine please see below for directions to access classroom assignments/work:

- **Grades K-4:** Parents should contact their child's teacher for any missed work and for any guidance or clarifications via *Remind*.
- **Grades 5-12:** Students are told to check *Google Classroom* for assignments & then email teachers directly if they have any questions or need clarification.
